Bill introduced, numbered, read first time, and referred to committee by the Lt. Gov.

SENATE

Committee chair sets bill for a public hearing.

Bill is approved by the committee by a majority vote

Bill is not approved by the committee

Substitute or Amendment

No Amendment

The bill is more than likely dead, but, it may be revived by the Senate

1. The bill is sent to be scheduled to be presented to the full Senate chamber

2. Second reading, debate, amendment, and passage to third reading

3. Third reading, debate, amendment, final passage

4. Amendment engrossed, and bill passed to the House

Bill received, read first time, and referred to committee by Speaker

HOUSE

Committee chair sets bill for a public hearing.

Bill is approved by the committee by a majority vote

Bill is not approved by the committee

Substitute or Amendment
