What is the Family Planning Program (FPP)?

The Family Planning Program is a general revenue funded, limited-benefit program that serves uninsured men and women across Texas.

Services covered include:

- Birth control
- Cancer screenings
- Chronic disease testing & treatment

Vital healthcare source for under-resourced Texans:

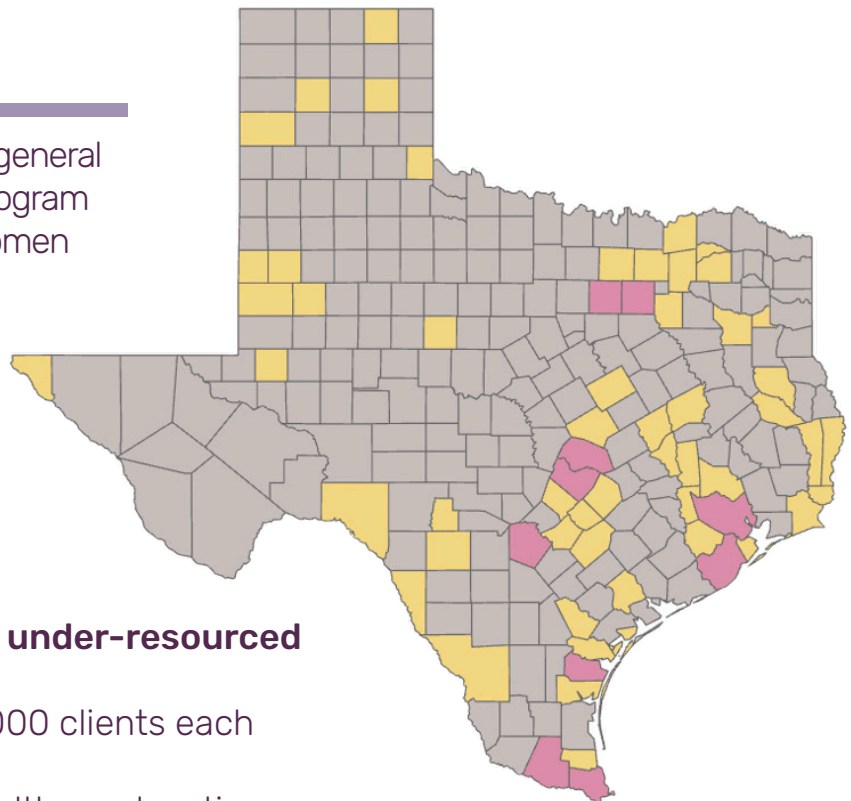
- Serves approximately 114,000 clients each year
- It operates through 193 healthcare locations

Program Stabilization:

- The 88th legislature made huge investments in this program to stabilise providers who were consistently exceeding their contracts and absorbing costs

Future Needs:

- There is a shortage of providers, particularly in West Texas & the Panhandle, with 74% of Texas counties lacking an FPP provider
