Healthy Texas Women (HTW)

What is Healthy Texas Women (HTW)?

Healthy Texas Women (HTW) is a Medicaid waiver, limited-benefit program that provides healthcare and family planning services to women aged 15-44 with low income and no insurance.

⌵ Services covered include:

- Birth control
- Cancer screenings
- Chronic disease testing & treatment

⌵ Vital healthcare source for under-resourced Texans in Fiscal Year 2024:

- Approximately 380,000 women were enrolled in HTW
- ≈ 3,000 healthcare providers served under HTW

⌵ Program growth in Fiscal Year 2024:

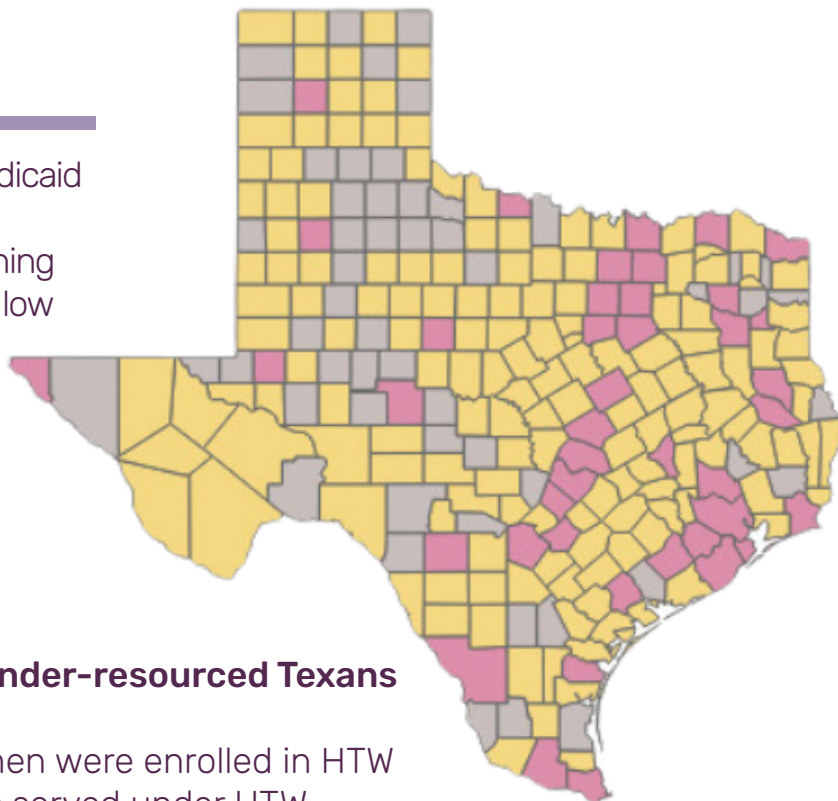
- Approximately 148,000 women received services through HTW. (A 4.29% increase from FY 2023.)
- ≈ 99,000 women were transitioned from CHIP, Medicaid, or Medicaid for Pregnant Women to HTW after their renewal was completed and eligibility redetermined

⌵ Program funding:

- \$268,618,909 in Federal and State Funding was invested into the program for FY 26 - FY 27

⌵ Program challenges:

- Long & arduous application forms
- Delayed application processing times
